ADMISSIONS OF TRAINEES INTO NATIONAL TECHNICIAN DIPLOMA, TRAINING YEAR 2026/27

Reference is made to the Technical and Vocational Education and Training (Admission of Trainees to TVET Providers) Regulations, 2026 (Copy attached). The Regulations provide for the admission of trainees to TVET providers, including institutional responsibilities, admission requirements, admission capacities, admission procedures, selection and admission decisions, and appeals.

The admission to National Technician Diploma programmes for the Training Year 2026/2027 shall be conducted not later than 23rd September 2026, and all admitted trainees to National Technician Diploma programmes for the training Year 2026/27 will report not later than 7th October 2026.

Admissions shall be conducted through respective management structures/committees for Private TVET providers, and admission committees for public and government grant-aided TVET providers. Each TVET provider therefore, should constitute their management/admission committees in accordance with the Technical and Vocational Education and Training (Admission of Trainees to TVET Providers) Regulations, 2026, and the Terms of Reference for Admissions Committees herewith attached not later than 17th September 2026.

You are therefore required to familiarize yourselves with these Regulations, and ensure that all necessary institutional arrangements are in place for the effective and timely conduct of the 2026/2027 National Technician Diploma admissions exercise.
